## ORDER

As per Notification read (1) above the University invited application from affiliated Medical colleges only for starting new Medical PG courses for the year 2020-21 and the colleges cannot apply for new Pharmacy colleges based on this U.O. Hon'ble High Court directed the University to open the respective portals and make available the prescribed format for preferring application for affiliation Vide Judgement read (2) above. Accordingly the Chairman, Indira Gandhi Memorial Trust, Kothamangalam has submitted application for starting B.Pharm course with 60 seats in KMP College of Pharmacy,Perumbavoor vide read (3) above.

2. Further Hon'ble Supreme court of India directed the University to consider the matter of affiliation within one week vide read (4) above.Accordingly University appointed an Inspection Commission for granting Provisional Affiliation to the KMP College of Pharmacy for starting B.Pharm course with 60 seats vide U.O. read (5)above.The report submitted by the Inspection Commission was scrutinized by the Scrutiny Committee vide paper read (6) above and recommended to grant Provisional Affiliation to start B.Pharm course for the year 2019-20 on rectifying deficiencies. After considering the inspection and scrutiny reports it was decided that conditional provisional affiliation be granted to the college subject to ratification by the GC.The same was communicated to the college through letter referred read (7) above,and thus the directions issued by the Hon'ble Courts are complied with.

3. The Institute has submitted approval from PCI and AICTE vide paper (8) & (9) above for conducting B.Pharm course with an annual intake of 60 seats during the year 2019-20.The College has remitted the

required Provisional Affiliation Fee and Refundable Deposit as notified in the U O No.6296/AC.B/KUHS/2013 dated 31.07.2018.

4. Sanction, has therefore been accorded by the Vice-Chancellor by exercising the powers conferred under chapter 3, section 12(7) of Kerala University of Health Sciences Act, 2010 to grant Conditional Provisional Affiliation to KMP College of Pharmacy, Perumbavoor for conducting B.Pharm course with an intake of 60 seats during the year 2019-20 subject to ratification by the Governing Council on the conditions detailed below:-

i) The college should obtain Essentiality Certificate from the Govt and should rectify the deficiencies mentioned in the letter no. 12923/ACII/Pharm/A3/2019 dated 09.08.2019 before 1st Semester Examination.

ii) The affiliation granted is subject to satisfactory legal scrutiny reports of the land documents

iii) Admission of the students is subject to extension of the cut-off date fixed by the University based on Supreme Court direction, that is 15.08.2019. The registration of the students admitted in the college is subject to approval from AFRC.

iv) Selection, admission and collection of fees shall be made only on the basis of the rules and regulations of the University/Govt. of Kerala and on the basis of the direction issued by the University/Govt. of Kerala from time to time, failing which the affiliation granted will be cancelled.

v) In the light of the direction of the Supreme Court of India in WP(c) 656/1998, the institution shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form. In case of failure to prevent the instances of ragging, appropriate action including withdrawal of affiliation of the College will be initiated.

vi) Affiliation granted is strictly provisional and only for the academic year 2019-20 The College has to apply for continuation of provisional affiliation for the ensuing years remitting the fee fixed by the University, along with a copy of letter of approval from the apex bodies concerned.

vii) Admission to the next academic year shall be made only after obtaining prior permission from the University.

viii) The College has to remit annual administration fee fixed for U G Course during 2019-20

ix) The College should collect fees\*\*\*from the students to be remitted to the University as follows:-
