ORDER

As per paper read (1) above University invited applications for Continuation of Provisional Affiliation for the Academic year 2020-21 from colleges for courses affiliated to this University. The Principals of Pharmacy Colleges mentioned in para (5) below have submitted application and remitted required fee for Continuation of Provisional Affiliation for the year 2020-21 .

2. Applications were processed by the University and inspections were conducted at the Colleges. The reports submitted by the Inspection Commission were verified by the Scrutiny Committee. The deficiencies pointed out by the Committee were intimated to the Colleges and the Colleges have furnished Compliance reports rectifying of deficiencies. After verification of the inspection report, the Scrutiny Committee recommended to grant Continuation of Provisional Affiliation to the Colleges for the Year 2020-2021.

3.The Governing Council vide paper read (2) above decided that AICTE approval is not mandatory for the grant of Provisional Affiliation/ Continuation of Provisional Affiliation to Pharmacy colleges,considering the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India stipulating Pharmacy Council of India as the authority to regulate the Pharmacy education in India.

4.The Governing Council vide paper read (3) above decided to grant Continuation of Provisional Affiliation to the Pharmacy Colleges mentioned in para (5) below for the Academic year 2020-21 based on recommendations of Scrutiny Committee, subject to receipt of renewal permission from PCI.Now, all the Colleges mentioned at para(5) below have submitted renewal permission from PCI for the Academic Year 2020-21. As stipulated in Chapter XXI of First Statutes of the University, the Colleges have constituted College Council.

5. In these circumstances, Continuation of Provisional Affiliation is granted to the following Pharmacy colleges for conducting the courses with annual intake of students specified against



each during the academic Year 2020–21 as detailed below.

6.The Colleges shall strictly adhere to the general conditions detailed below:–

i) Selection, admission and collection of fees shall be made only on the basis of the rules and regulations of the University/Govt. of Kerala and on the basis of the direction issued by the University from time to time, failing which the affiliation granted will be cancelled.

ii) In the light of the direction of the Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition(c)56/1998, the institution shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form. In case of failure to prevent the instances of ragging, appropriate action including withdrawal of affiliation of the College will be initiated.



iii) Affiliation granted is strictly provisional and only for the academic year 2020–21. The college has to apply for continuation of provisional affiliation for the ensuing years remitting the fee fixed by the University, along with a copy of letter of approval from the apex bodies concerned.

iv) The Colleges should remit annual administration fee fixed for UG/PG courses for the academic year 2020–21.

v) Admission to the next academic year shall be made only after obtaining prior permission from the University.
